- The annual February wild game banquet will be held on Wednesday February 8th starting at 5:30pm at the Consumers Energy party room located at 2074 242nd St, Marshalltown, IA 50158. Steve Dermand, a retired Iowa DNR information specialist will be the night's program. He coordinated many things including being a representative for the T.I.P. program.... Turn In Poachers. Hunters, Fishermen and fur trappers buy licenses annually and with that is typically a fee of \$2 that is added and goes to the TIP fund. The portion of what TIP's board of directors gets is used to sustain projects and to pay confidential informants a small "reward" for the information they shared with conservation officers. Those TIP's are responsible for successful prosecution of cases involving natural resource misuse by the bad guys. Dermand will explain the process and illustrate how a simple TIP may stay simple....or lead to long investigations statewide, or nation-wide, and involve many people in the business of crimes against natural resources. You won't want to miss this popular event! Invite your friends and family, bring a wild game dish, side dish or desert to share with everyone. This is a great time and a good way to introduce people to the Ikes, the outdoors and to the delights of wild fish and game.
